APRIL 22nd & 23rd**

ACCEPTED...**

The Annual Spring Cleanup provides residents the convenience of a local drop-off to recycle or dispose of unwanted items from their residences. This year's Cleanup is scheduled for Saturday/Sunday (April 22nd & 23rd) at the Public Works facility (1030 Roe Street). Event times are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. both days. Resident I.D. (current utility bill/driver's license) is required. The event is open only to Town residents and Steilacoom Sewer Utility customers; no commercial haulers, landscapers, contractors, etc.

Spring Cleanup is extremely popular, waiting times can exceed 1 hour. The best way to reduce your time in line, is to load your vehicle properly with acceptable materials. Please read and observe the following event guidelines.

RESTRICTIONS:
NO tv's, computers, monitors, vegetation, yardwaste, dirt, rocks, sod, stumps, bricks, chunks of concrete, roofing materials, propane tanks, quantities of construction materials or anything with a compressor (like refrigerators). No tires, on or off the rim, or hazardous materials of any kind. No mixtures of vegetation with other disposables and no household garbage (such as food wastes). Remember, due to liability concerns, the Town has the right to refuse any materials. *In order to be fair to everyone waiting in line, we are limiting vehicle loads to no larger than a pickup truck or a 4'X8' trailer.* Your assistance in unloading your vehicle is required.

VEHICLE LOADING:
Load your vehicle in the following order: disposables, scrap metals, Life Center Thrift items and then cardboard. Items will be unloaded in reverse order.

CELL PHONES:
Unwanted cellular phones will be collected for recycling at the I.D. Check.

CARDBOARD
Empty boxes, break down and flatten. No Styrofoam peanuts, food-contaminated,

foil-covered, or wax-coated boxes.

LIFE CENTER THRIFT:
Accepts usable furniture, small household items, clothing, sporting equipment, toys, etc.

SCRAP METAL:
No refrigerators or other items with compressors. No propane tanks – take them to the HHW facility at the entrance to the Tacoma Landfill (591-5418).
